Subject: CYLINDER HEAD IDENTIFICATION - 1967-1/2 AND 1968 ENGINES

Some 1967-1/2 V-8, 400 cu. in. engines incorporated the use of a new cylinder head. This head may be identified in the same manner as other 1967 heads by noting the number code cast in the head at the center exhaust port. The new head and its corresponding engine applications are shown on the attached page. Cylinder heads for all other 1967 engines may be identified by referring to the first page, 2nd edition, of the 1967 Service Craftsman News.

Cylinder heads for 1968 V-8 engines may be identified in the same manner as 1967 heads. The casting number is located on the center exhaust port, but the cast stamp consists of only two (2) digits as compared to three (3) digits on 1967 heads.

Cylinder heads on 1968 6-cylinder engines can be identified by a seven (7) digit production number cast in the head just below the rocker arm cover sealing edge. Since the production number is inside the rocker arm cover, the cover will have to be removed before the number can be seen.

The attached tables show the identification codes for the 1967-1/2 -1968 V-8 engines and the production numbers for the 1968 6-cylinder engines.
