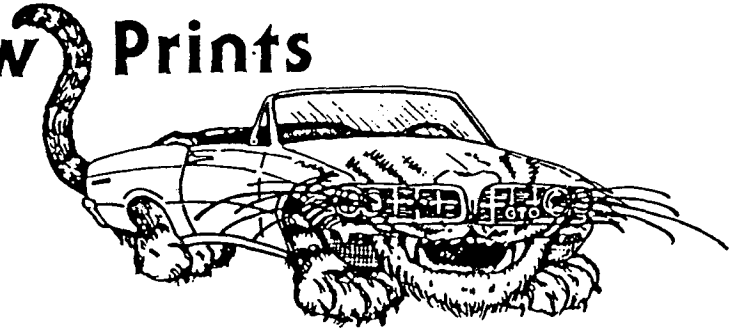

50/50 Drawing: Jim Brownfield was this months winner. \$10.00 will go to our charity at the end of the year.

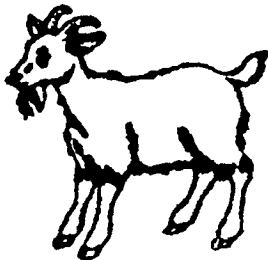

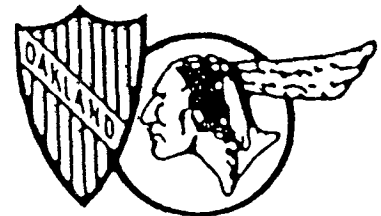

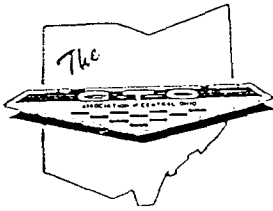
