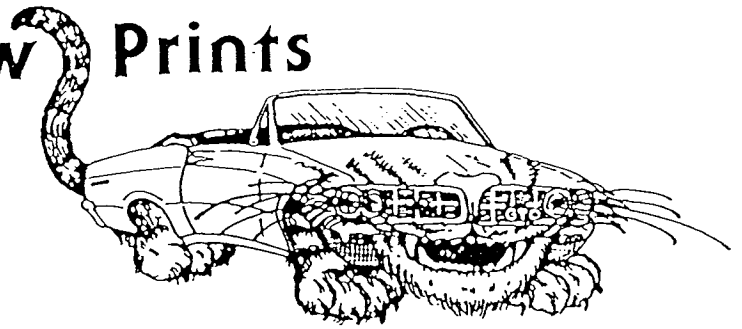

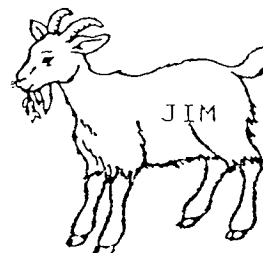

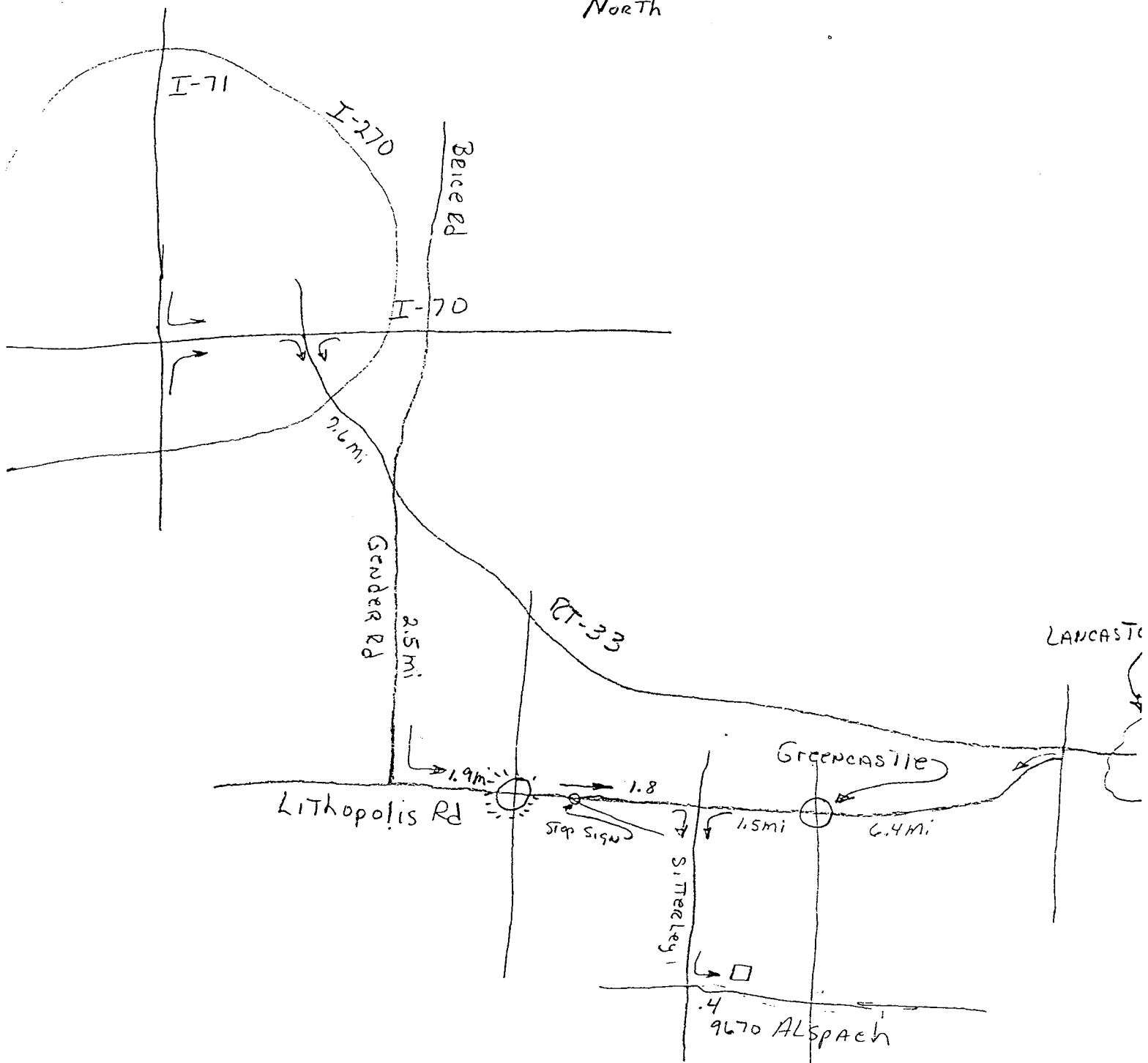

FROM THE LIGHT TO SETTERLY IS 1.8 MI TURN RIGHT ON SETTERLY 1.4 MI TO ALSPACH, TURN LEFT ON ALSPACH TO 9670 ALSPACH .4 MILES ON LEFT.

IF YOU ARE COMING FROM LANCASTER, GO NORTH OUT LANCASTER ON RT.33 1.1 ML PAST TAYLOR CHEV. 50/50 drawing winner was Kevin Johnston \$7.00 goes into charity funds.

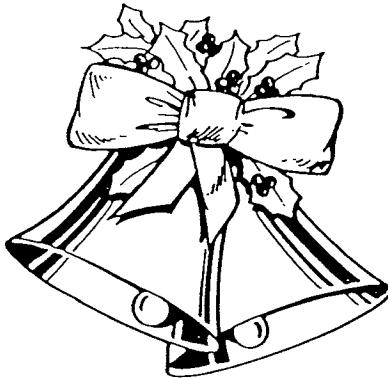
After the meeting Neal Blankenship will use his library of parts books to look up parts and see if they are available for club members.

SUBJECT: VEHICLE IDENTIFICATION PLATE DELIVERY DATE STAMP

This bulletin supersedes Service Management letter 65-3 which should be destroyed.

Again in 1965, a space is provided for stamping the delivery date of each vehicle on the plate attached to the left hand pillar post at the time the car is delivered to the original owner.

The location of the space provided for the date stamp has been changed from that in 1964. Three digits are to be stamped in the space provided indicating the month and year as outlined below.

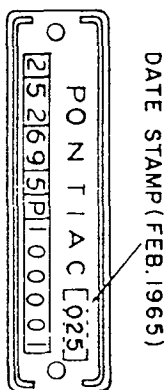
