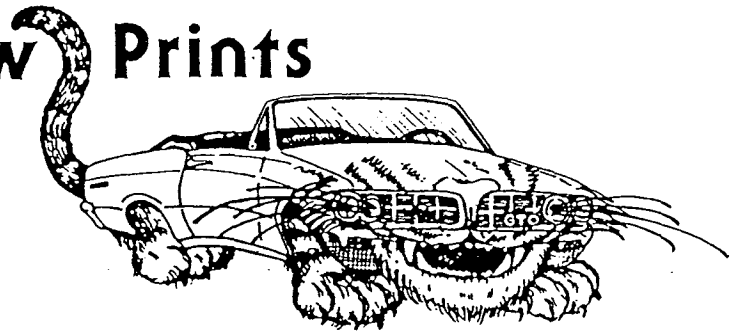

Larry Baltzell won 2nd place in 65 modified gto with his blue 65 hardtop.

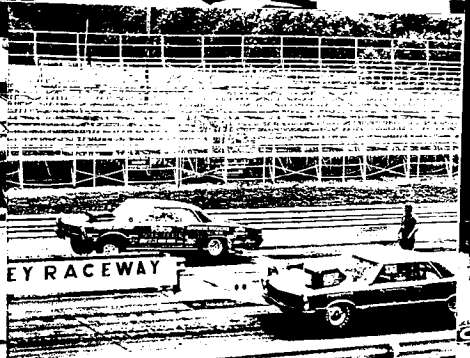
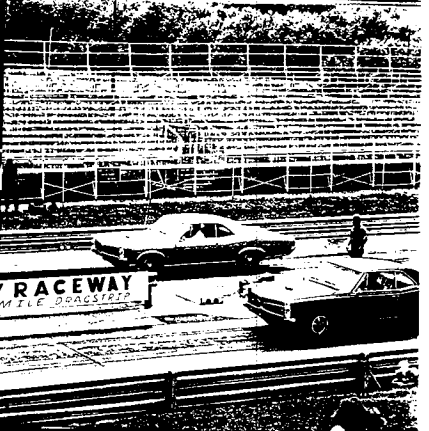
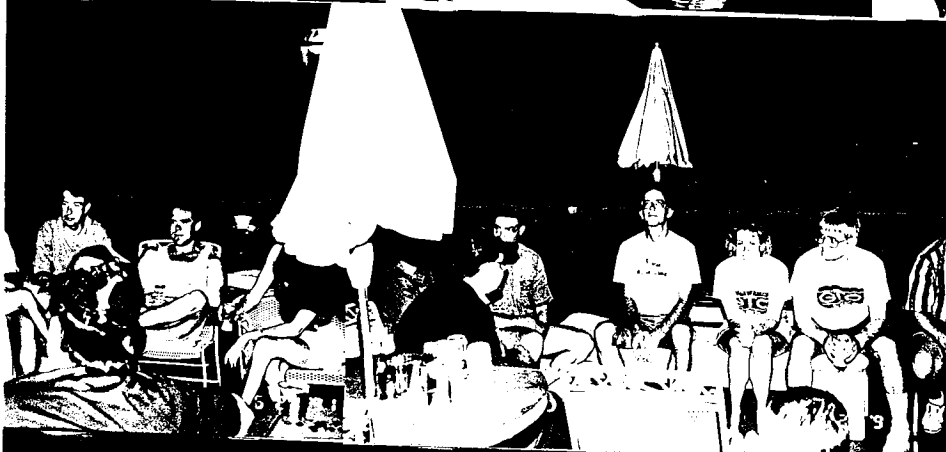
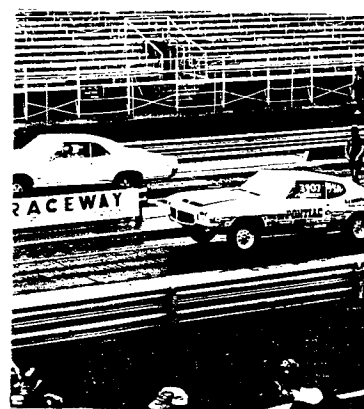
Kris Ten Eyck took 3rd place at the drags with his gold 66 hardtop.
