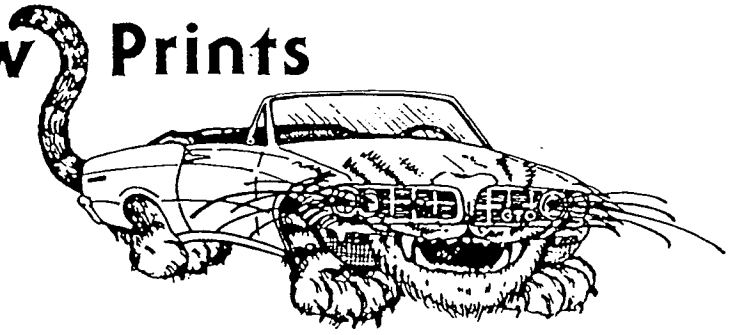

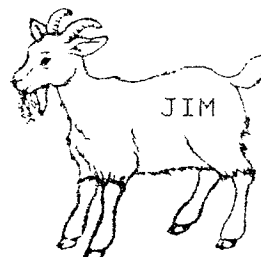
WE ALSO HAD A GOOD TIME LOOKING AT ALL THE CARS FRANK HAS.

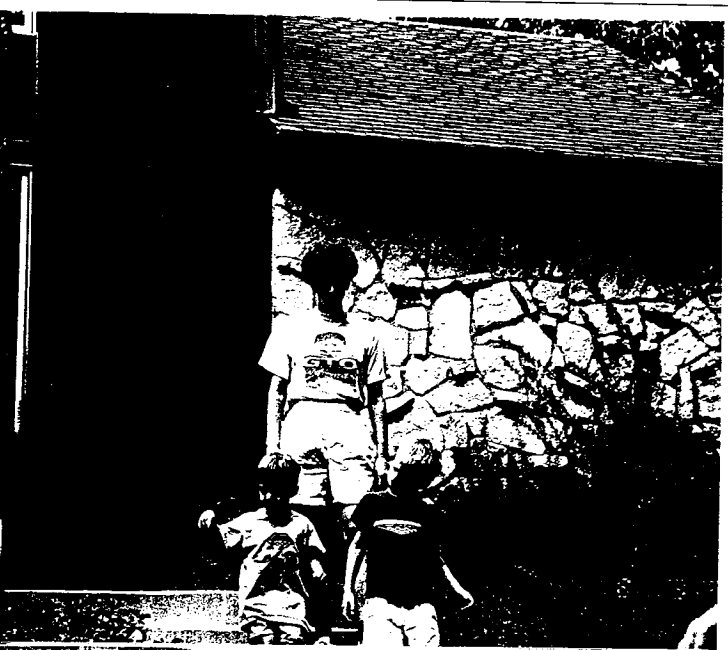

Subject: PLANT IDENTIFICATION CODES
(St. Therese and Fremont Plants)CONDITION

Improper plant identification (contained in V.I. number) is being received on some Early Product Information Reports.

St. Therese, Quebec, recently began building "B" cars. This plant is assigned the digit 2 as a plant identifier. For example: 2623902107845. When written in longhand, the digit 2 (St. Therese identifier) and the letter Z (Fremont identifier) often appear quite similar.

CORRECTION

Correct vehicle identification information is necessary on Early Quality Reports to properly evaluate conditions by plant. Therefore, when inserting the vehicle identification number of Fremont built vehicles, further identify the letter Z by running a slash through its center. For example: 242370Z107845. By use of the slash "Z" system, plant identification will be clarified.
