



#### GTOACO MEETING MINUTES - JUNE 8, 1994

Meeting was called to order by Dave Benson, President. There were 17 members in attendance.

The Treasurer's Report was accepted as read.

The Secretary's minutes for the abbreviated March Meeting and for the April Meeting as was published in the Paw Prints was accepted. No minutes were taken during the absence of the Secretary at the May Meeting.

Our newest member, Craig Vance, was in attendance and introduced himself and told us about his car and his plans for it.

The majority of this meeting centered around the upcoming Spring Show. Jim talked with Aaron earlier in the day, and to date, there will be no police monitoring traffic. Jim was going to speak with Aaron once more about the possibility of providing one.

Kevin Johnston volunteered to purchase and bring pop for the Club Members helping during the Show.

Jeff Inskeep has taken inventory on the registration paperwork needs, and will have all the necessary forms at the Show on Sunday. He will also provide a "meal ticket" for all club members helping on Sunday.

Nancy Whaley has informed Jimmy's Jawbreakers about the potential number of people that will be in attendance on Sunday so that they should provide ample supplies and workers to keep their flow of customers moving and happy.

Show Chairman, Jim Evans feels that things seem to be falling in to place and will work out fine. It is a continuing concern that not all club members step forward to help during the show - this is our biggest event and the success of it depends on all our efforts. We thank everyone who have agreed to help this year and understand that not everyone had this day available to help.

Jeff Inskeep is a little concerned with the number of Judges and Judging Assistants that we have. He had hoped to have all names in place before the show and he may have to recruit members to step in to help on Sunday.

The weather looks like it will cooperate on Sunday for us too!

Fred Dowdy won the door prize - an insulated cooler.

Gary Turnmire won the 50/50 in the amount of \$8.00.

Meeting was adjourned.
