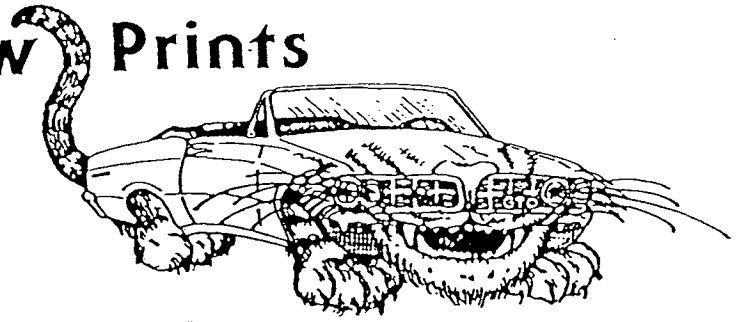

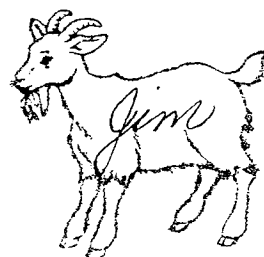

If you need an application please call Nancy and see will see that you get this information ASAP.

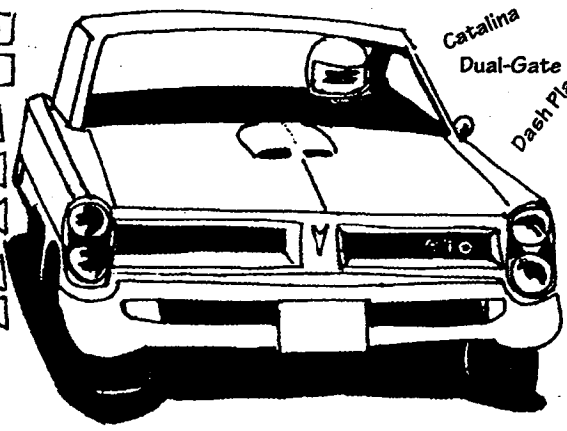
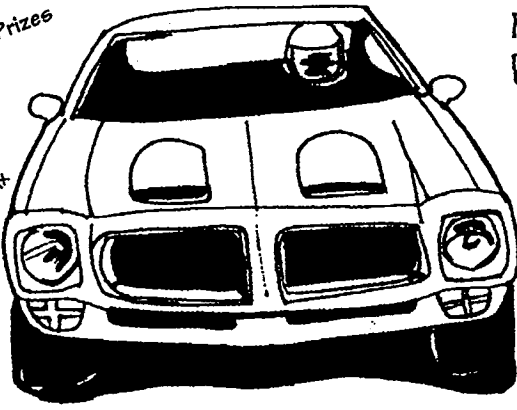

John Middlebrook, Pontiac general manager, was recently interviewed by Jim Mateja, Automotive writer for the Chicago Tribune. As reported in a trade publication, Motor Service, January 1995, Middlebrook says to forget the rebirth of the well-known, well-loved Pontiac G.T.O. It was long rumored to be destined for resurrection in an upcoming version of the Grand Am.

"We cannot find a platform to do one on," he says. "We won't do one on a front-wheel-drive platform. When we meet with G.T.O. clubs, they always say a G.T.O. has to be a rear-wheel-drive car with a V-8. The only car we have is Firebird, and we have great names on that car and don't need G.T.O."

Well Mr. Middlebrook lets let the G.T.O. remain a legend. You used another great name "LeMans" on a Korean imitation of an automobile. Don't make the same mistake again!

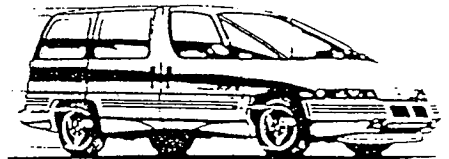

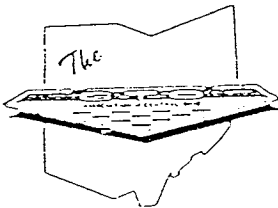
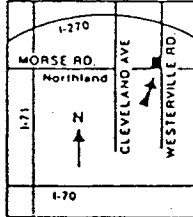
