GTOACO PAW PRINTS

Father and Son Pontiac by Steve Schaeffer

The life blood of any hobby or organization is youth. For the Pontiac hobby to continue to grow, young people must be encouraged to get involved.

I met Dr. Scott Kelly and his son Tracy thru my long time machinist Scott Murray. He and his brother own the local Carquest parts store in Lancaster, Ohio, Murray's Auto Parts. Dr. Kelly & his son are restoring a 1979 Firebird for Tracy's first car. It is wonderful to see father and son planning a project, reading all the catalogs, and building a car together.

Currently the body is on a rotisserie and they are working on the floor and the sub frame is out being sand blasted. Then it will be painted, rebuilt and detailed. They asked Scott Murray about rebuilding the Pontiac 301 engine that came with the car. Both he and I were concerned about a 301's durability and limited hop-up potential later on.

I had a 1978 Trans Am 400 engine available and it became the base for their project. We decided to build a very mild low horsepower 400 for the car. Then in a few years after Tracy has had some real seat time in the car we can add horsepower as desired. The only change to the short block would be to add a lot more cam.

The engine we built is patterned after the 1972 Pontiac 400 as used in the GTO and Firebird. It will have 250 net horsepower. The block is bored .030 oversize for 406 cubic inches. We used 4X casting cylinder heads with 96cc combustion chambers. They have 2.11 intake valves and 1.66 exhausts. They also have the factory bottle neck screw in rocker studs and pushrod guide plates. The induction system is from Edelbrock with a Performer intake and a 750 carb. The ignition system is all MSD including their Pro Billet distributor. For a camshaft we are using a Mellings copy of the Pontiac 066 4barrel cam. This cam has specs of 271 degrees and .404 on the intake side. The exhaust is 280 degrees and .408 lift. The oil pump is a Mellings 60 pound pump. Exhaust will be a nice set of coated headers.

Tracy is really getting a good education putting together his first engine. He has cleaned and painted parts. He helped to install the crankshaft as well as pistons, rings, rods etc. He torqued all the bolts to factory specifications and adjusted the valves. Even though we were using a stock cam we still adjusted them in order so the lifter would be on the base circle of the cam and not open.

The youthful enthusiasm is contagious. We are all having a great time with the project. Tracy wants the engine to have a very functional appearance; no chrome. The short block is painted semi-gloss black. The heads and intake manifold are white. They are set of with a rare set of black powder coated Pontiac aluminum valve covers. The engine is really sharp. Tracy is eager to reconnect the body and the sub frame. He hopes we can install the engine yet this year. He wants hear that first engine run. It will result in a real sence of accomplishment and pride in a project well done.




