Auctions America by Steve Schaeffer

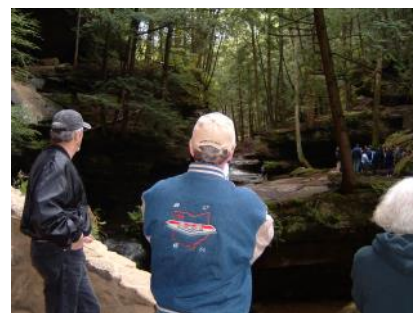

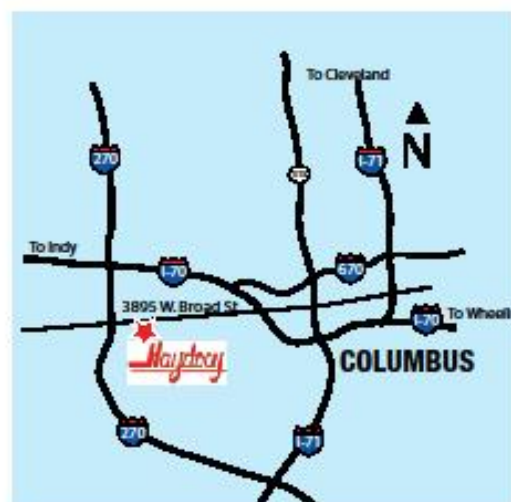

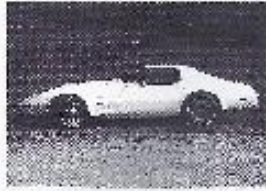
