At a local car show 125 cars is a good number. At most national events 500 to a 1,000 cars is a good turnout. Three days is not enough time to take it all in.

In addition to the cars there on display, there was also a huge swap meet, car corral, and manufacturer's midway. Most of the national companies and many top builders were there.

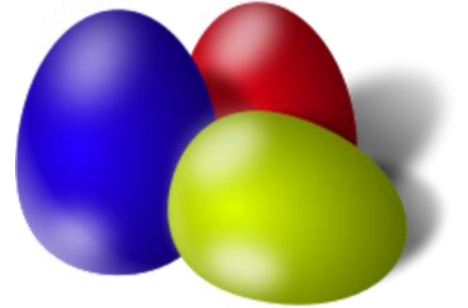

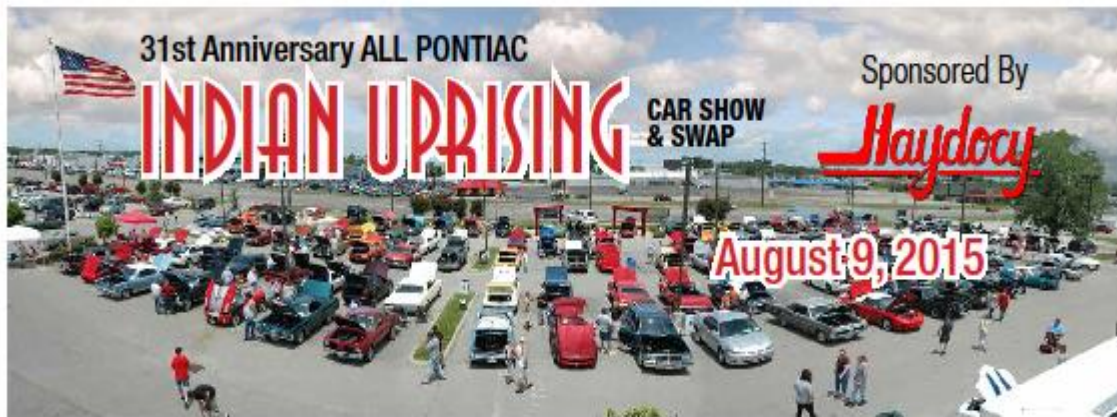
