The River Church in a Barn Car Rally

A beautiful early September day was the setting for this little cruise-in at a church in Delaware.

"CrowMod" Firebird by Steve Schaeffer

While attending the Performance Racing Industry Trade Show in Indianapolis I spotted Justin "Big Chief" Shearer's new Firebird race car. This car replaces the Tempest race car that was wrecked on the Street Outlaws TV show. This is the first Pro-Mod race car also designed to run on the street and it is powered by a Butler built turbo real Pontiac engine! It is the first real Pontiac powered car to run in the 3s in the eighth mile. It has 200 mph potential.

A Pro-Mod is a full tube chassis car with an extended wheel base, full rear suspension and a power adder. The power adder can be either a blower, turbo charger, or nitrous. Justin 's car is really a pseudo funny car with doors. These cars typically weigh under 2,500 pounds. The guy 's running back-hafted steel bodied real street cars on Discovery Channel 's "Street Outlaws" no longer have a chance.







