On behalf of Prevent Blindness, thank you for your donation of \$2900 to our Annual Sight-Saving Campaign. Your generosity brings our mission to life - to prevent blindness and preserve sight - like in the case of Ed, a client from one of our partner organizations.

Ed recently completed a job readiness training program and was offered employment that would allow him to become self -sufficient. Before the new employer would accept him, however, he needed to have his vision corrected. Ed did not have the resources to get an eye exam and glasses, so his caseworker contacted Prevent Blindness and we came to the rescue. After being chronically unemployed, Ed was able to start his new job on time and become a productive worker and taxpayer. Ed would not have received this help, if not for your support!





An "Oops" Moment on a Muncie 4 Speed

There is a pivot pin that goes through the side cover that the detent combs pivot on. The detent combs are part of the interlock mechanism so the transmission cannot engage two different gears at the same time.

The very early Muncie 4 speeds had a straight pivot pin that just pressed into the side cover. The revised pin has a "hat" on it that is clearly visible on the outside of the cover. The revised pin cannot pull thru the side cover and fall into the transmission.

The attached pictures are of a 1965 Muncie M-20 4 speed transmission. The 1st design pivot pin pulled thru the side cover letting the detent combs and spring fall into the case. As you can see from the before and after pictures the transmission sheared off a bunch of teeth on the cluster gear and also ruined both the second and third speed gears.

If you have an early Muncie 4 speed transmission be sure that the pivot pin has been replaced with the 2nd design pin with the "hat" on it. Now that these units are over 50 years old it appears that the stress over all these

years allows the 1st design pivot pin to no longer be a press fit in the side cover. If it pulls thru the attached pictures can show you what happens.


