NHRA Drag Racing

N.H.R.A. Drag Racing has changed dramatically over the years. My brother Michael and I ran a series of 60's Pontiacs and GTO's in the National Hot Rod Association Junior Stock Classes and later in the "Pro" Bracket Race Class. Over the years we had wins at Tri-State Drag Strip in Hamilton, Ohio, Edgewater Raceway Park in Cleves, Ohio, Kil-Kare in Xenia, Ohio, National Trails in Hebron, Ohio, Indianapolis Raceway Park, and Irwindale in California. We really thought we had fast cars with runs in the low 13's and even the high 12's. They say, "Old Racers Don't Die, they just go faster." Well the cars we are now working on really do.

Wally Zwicker's "Green Machine", a 550 horsepower small block powered '93 S-10 is coming along nicely. We have installed the engine and transmission and it is now a rolling chassis. It appears the race weight is going to be in the 2800 pound range. We are still looking at 10.40's at 130 MPH in the quarter mile.

Steve Gauerke's '27 T Roadster with a 502 Big Block runs 9.90's at over 150 MPH in the quarter mile. What is more remarkable is this is with a throttle stop! The car will really run 8.90's. It is not that many years ago that was gas dragster territory. So the chassis can be recertified we just removed the entire body for the chassis inspection.

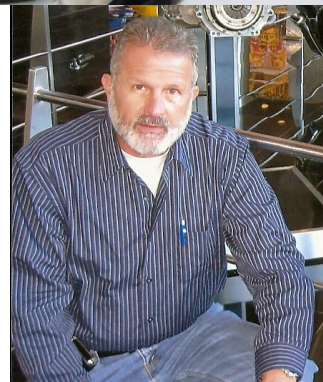

N.H.R.A. rules require that any car running 9.99 or quicker must have a serialized chassis sticker affixed to the frame before participating at any N.H.R.A. member track event. All chassis must be recertified every three years. You really need a current rule book. There are specifications for tubing size, type of welds, roll cages, and a ton of safety regulations. They always said, "Speed costs, how fast can you afford to go?"

We trailered Steve's roadster up to Couglin Automotive in Newark. N.H.R.A. was doing inspections in their body shop. The Chassis Certification was very complete. The inspector checked all the tubes in the tubular chassis with a Go No Go Gauge to verify the diameter of each tube. He also checked the thickness of each tube with a sonic tester. He verified that the car had the correct roll cage and inspected all the welds. All the correct specifications are listed in the rule book. There are different specs for a mild steel chassis and one manufactured out of chrome-moly.

After the roadster passed the chassis inspection we then went to get an ETI sticker. This is a very detailed technical inspection. The complete list of everything that they check is a full page long and it is all listed in the rule book. Briefly they looked at engine, drivetrain, brakes, suspension, tires, wheels, body, electrical, helmet, fire suit, seat belts, credentials, etc. The nice thing about having the ETI sticker is that when you go thru tech inspection at the drag strip you are in the "express line."

I was impressed at how professional and how thorough the inspectors and inspections were.

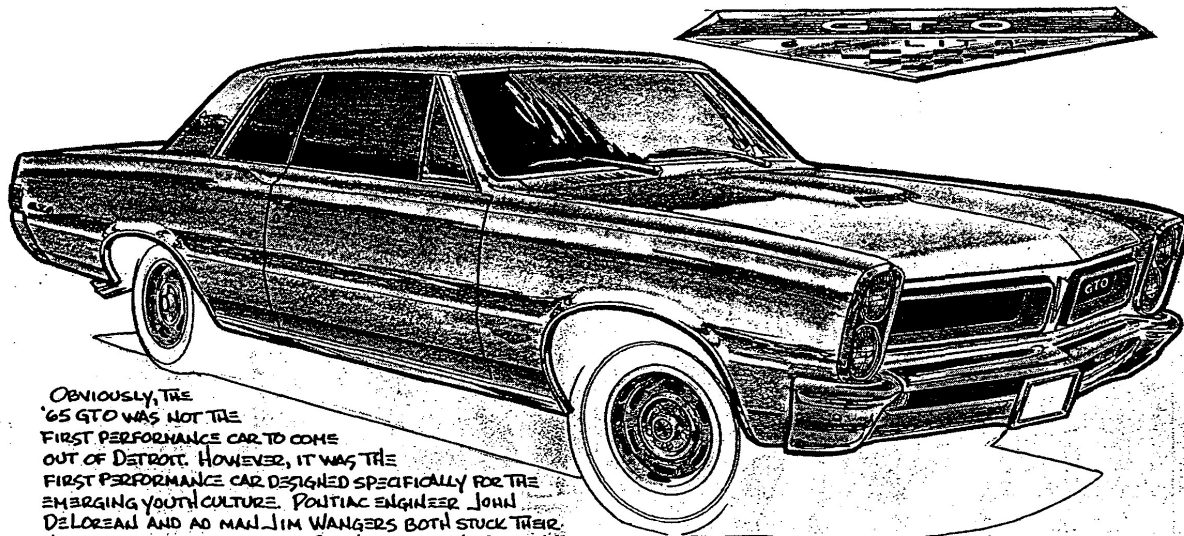
- ◆ Ron Cozzo got his 66 LeMans metal work has begun!

Blast from the Past!

This month's Blast from the Past is from the October 1991 Paw Prints. A neat hand drawn article about the 1965 GTO. No source is cited. Perhaps one of you remember?

THE HISTORY OF MUSCLE CARS



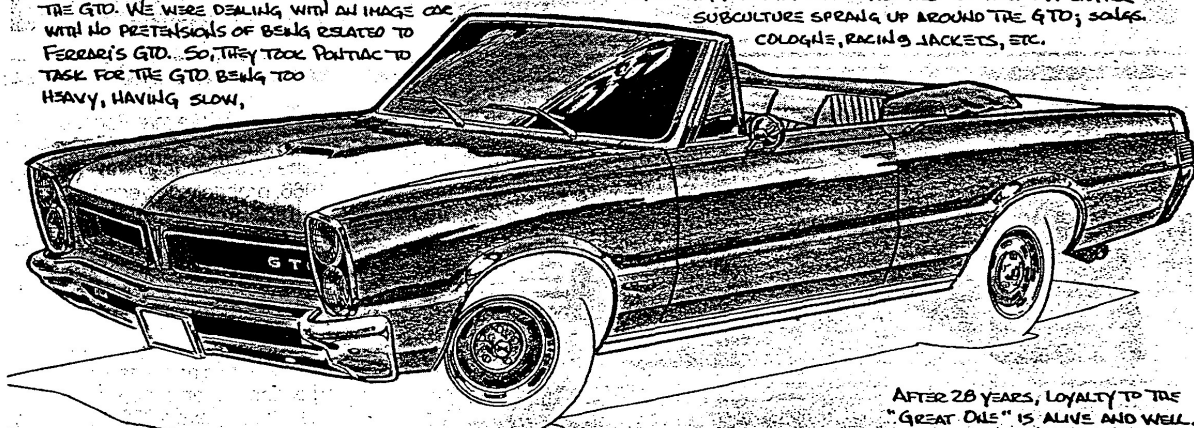
OBVIOUSLY, THE '65 GTO WAS NOT THE FIRST PERFORMANCE CAR TO COME OUT OF DETROIT. HOWEVER, IT WAS THE FIRST PERFORMANCE CAR DESIGNED SPECIFICALLY FOR THE EMERGING YOUTH CULTURE. PONTIAC ENGINEER JOHN DE LOREAN AND AD MAN JIM WANGERS BOTH STUCK THEIR NECKS OUT AND HIT PAY DIRT. BY THE END OF '64, PONTIAC SOLD 32,450 GTO'S AND THE MUSCLECAR WARS HAD BEGUN.

THESE WERE THE DAYS WHEN THERE WERE SIGNIFICANT BODY CHANGES EVERY YEAR. THE '65 GTO RECEIVED VERTICAL QUAD HEADLIGHTS, A SPLIT FRONT GRILLE, AND COULD BE ORDERED AS A COUPE, HARDTOP, OR CONVERTIBLE. THE FORWARD-LEANING HEADLIGHTS GAVE THE GTO AN AGGRESSIVE STANCE. ALONG WITH THE CRISP NEW FENDER LINES THE '65 GTO HAD A COMPLETELY UNIQUE LOOK. THERE WAS NO MISTAKING IT FOR A '64 OR '66 EDITIAL.

SINCE THE CAR WAS NEVER INTENDED TO BE A RACER THE PERFORMANCE UPGRADES WERE ALL BOLT ON. MAGAZINES LIKE CAR & DRIVER AND CAR LIFE MOST HAVE MISUNDERSTOOD THE PREMISE OF THE GTO. WE WERE DEALING WITH AN IMAGE CAR WITH NO PRETENSIONS OF BEING RELATED TO FERRARI'S GTO. SO, THEY TOOK PONTIAC TO TASK FOR THE GTO BEING TOO HEAVY, HAVING SLOW,

MUSHY STEERING, AND WALLOWING THROUGH CORNERS. HOWEVER, THEY WERE BESIDES THEMSELVES OVER THE GTO'S BEUTE, BLASTING POWER. WITH 3.90 GEARS, THE 340 BHP VERSION RAN 0 TO 60 IN 4.6 SECONDS AND THE 1/4 MILE IN 13.1 SECONDS AT 114 MPH. TOP SPEED WAS 115 MPH. SO THE WORD WAS OUT AND 75,352 GTO'S WERE SOLD IN '65.

GRANTED, THOSE PERFORMANCE FIGURES WERE MOST LIKELY PRODUCED BY A PONTIAC-PREPARED CAR. ON THE STREET, UNDER NORMAL CIRCUMSTANCES, MOST GTO'S WERE NOT THAT STRONG. BUT THAT'S REALLY BESIDES THE POINT. GTO'S WERE ALWAYS CONTENDERS BECAUSE ONE NEVER KNEW IF THE GTO NEXT TO HIM WAS "WORKED" OR NOT. AN ENTIRE SUBCULTURE SPANG UP AROUND THE GTO; SOLES, COLOGNE, RACING JACKETS, ETC.
